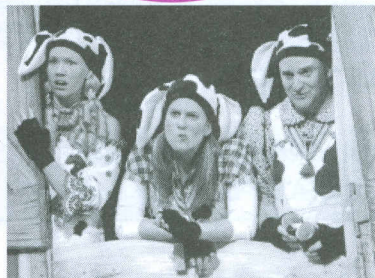

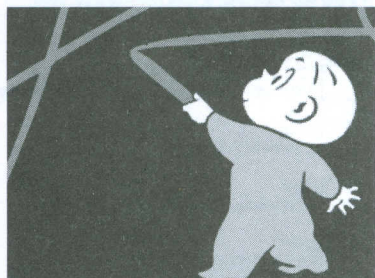


## CLICK, CLACK, MOO

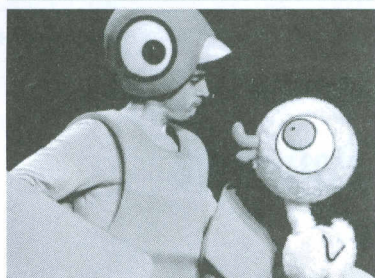


## The Adventures of HAROLD and the PURPLE CRAYON

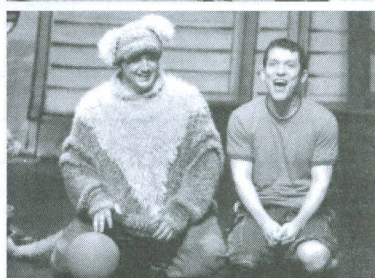
## Pigeon Party!

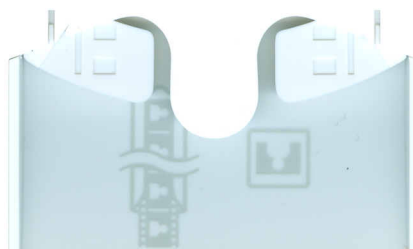
